

These estimates are based on data from the 2018-19 Local Control Funding Formula Snapshot (Second Principal Apportionment), found on the California Department of Education website (cde.ca.gov), and the October 2019 Legislative Analysist Office estimate of the increased revenue resulting from passage of the initiative. This is the most current, and accurate, data available. Because implementation of the Act is not scheduled to begin until 2022-23, there will be some adjustments to the proportional distribution of funding due to inherent variables within the state funding formula during the intervening years (such as changes to COLA, Average Daily Attendance fluctuations, and Unduplicated Pupil Percentage counts). Given that, these estimates are reasonable based on currently available data but are subject to change as that data is updated.
